

## WEEE Collection and Recycling Arrangements in Estonia

Nutanix products are sold in Estonia by dealers and distributors. The dealers and distributors act as the importer of the equipment into Estonia. Thus, the dealers and distributors have the legal responsibility to:

- Register as the WEEE producer in Estonia.
- Provide arrangements for collection and recycling of WEEE arising from Nutanix products that the dealer and distributor sells in Estonia.

Under the Estonian Waste Act as well as Regulation 154, for equipment that you buy from Nutanix after August 13th 2005, the Nutanix distributor is required to provide arrangements for the collection, treatment, recycling and recovery of the waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) that your new purchase replaces, on a one-for-one, like-for-like basis. The old equipment that your new purchase from Nutanix replaces is referred to as Historic WEEE.

Under the Decree, the Nutanix distributor is also required to provide arrangements for the collection, treatment, recycling and recovery of any new electrical and electronic equipment that you buy from Nutanix after August 13th 2005, when that new equipment eventually becomes waste. This is referred to as new WEEE.

Nutanix has decided to join the compliance scheme Elektroonikaromu on behalf of its distributors in Estonia to manage all aspects of WEEE collection and recycling in Estonia. Please contact Elektroonikaromu below to arrange collection of the WEEE
